Tenders will be evaluated and awarded as follows:

Stage 1: Pre-Qualification

Only tenders scoring a minimum of 60 out of 70 points in stage 1 will be further considered for evaluation in stage 2.

Stage 2:

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000) Regulations 2011 and the George Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy, where 90 points will be scored for price and 10 points for B-BBEE status.
